Introduction of Seoul International Drama Awards

Seoul International Drama Awards (SDA) is the world's leading festival for global TV dramas, which is annually hosted in Seoul, Korea, a country widely known as the hub of trendy TV dramas. Organized by non-profit organizations, Korean Broadcasters Association and Seoul Drama Awards Organizing Committee, the awards ceremony is telecast on the three major terrestrial channels KBS, MBC, and SBS interchangeably every two years. The competition-based awards ceremony was launched in 2006, when there were no such award shows in Asia. The SDA cordially invites the world's TV drama experts and talent, and global fans to the 12th Awards Ceremony on September 7.







'Love in the Moonlight' wins two prizes at Seoul Int'l Drama Awards

SEDUL, Sept. 8 (Yonhap) – KBS 2 TV's "Love in the Moonlight" received two awards from this year's Secul International Drama Awards (SDA) while the annual event was overshadowed by the on-going labor strike at the network.

The popular drama, which aired Aug. 22-Oct. 18, 2016, and featured Park Bo-gurn and Kim Yoo-jung, won best drama and best actor in the Korean Wave or, or hallyu, category.

The awards ceremony took place at KBS Hall in Seoul's Yeouido on Thursday at 7 p.m. The show was planned to air live, but was forced to cancel as a staff shortage disrupted the network's operation. It will air midnight Friday.

The best program award went to "This is Us," an American TV series created by Dan Fogelman on NBC. The German drama "Redemption Road" won best TV movie. Best miniseries went to Belgium drama "Please Love Me."

Turkish actor Kerem Bursin of "Heart of the City" won best actor while Russian actress Aleksandra Nikiforova who played in "Detective Anna" won best actress.

Korean actors Park Bo-gum and Park Bo-young of "Strong Woman Do Bong-soon" both received best actor and best actress, respectively, in the hallyu category.
